


Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035

In Moldova, the age 65+ population will increase 61% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will shrink 9%. For comparison, Moldova's age 65+ growth rate ranks #158 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #1 out of 10 in Eastern Europe.




