


# Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035

In Lebanon, the age 65+ population will increase 84% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will shrink 10%. For comparison, Lebanon's age 65+ growth rate ranks #119 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #14 out of 18 in Western Asia.

#### "Old Age" Dependency Ratio





#### What is a dependency ratio?

An "old age" dependency ratio is the number of people age 65+ per 100 "working age" people age 20-64. It is therefore intended to measure burden on the working population to provide pensions and support for retirees.

#### How does Lebanon compare?

The old age dependency ratio in Lebanon is 13.9. This means there are 13.9 people age 65+ per 100 people age 20-64. Based on this ratio, Lebanon ranks #78 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #5 out of 18 in Western Asia, in terms of pressure on working populations to support retirees.



In 2015, the median age in Lebanon was 28.5. The country ranks #100 out of 201 nations and territories in the world,


