




Change in Population by Age: 2015-2035

In Denmark, the age 65+ population will increase 37% between 2015 and 2035 (compared to an 89% increase globally during this period). Meanwhile its total population will increase by just 7%. For comparison, Denmark's age 65+ growth rate ranks #180 out of 201 nations and territories in the world, and #6 out of 11 in Northern Europe.






